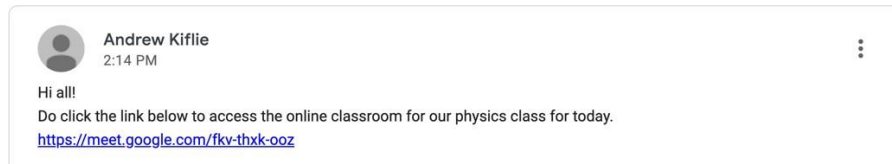
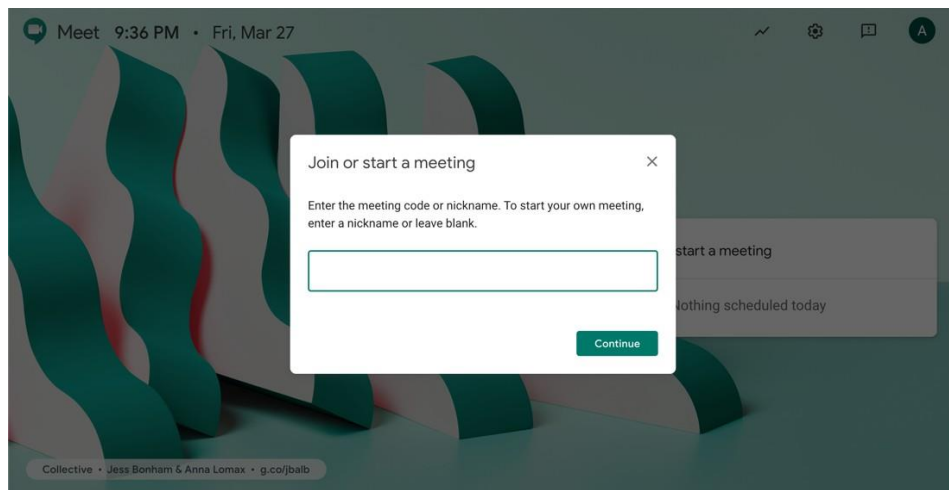


Using Google Meet as a Student:

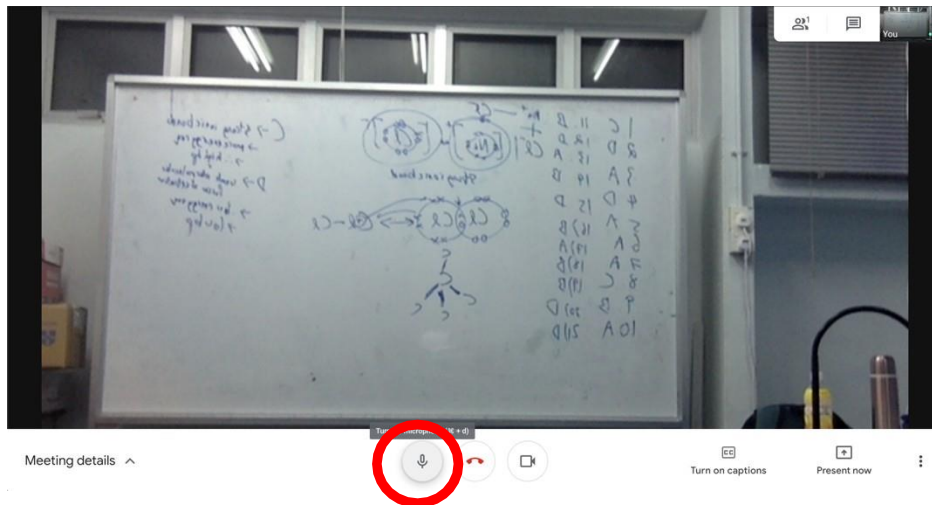
- 1) Ensure you are in a **LOW SOUND** environment. It helps the entire class as there will be less ambient noise. If you are using a handheld device, download the Google Meet application from **Apple App Store** or **Google Play**.
- 2) There are two ways to access the Google Meet classroom.
 - a. Click on the link provided by your tutor.



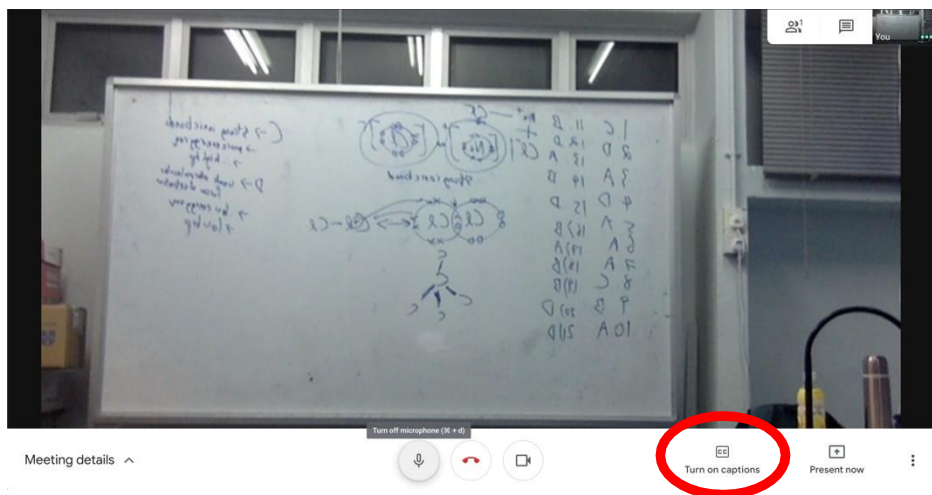
- b. Join a class by keying in the meeting code for the class. Go to <http://meet.google.com>, key in the code, and click "Continue."



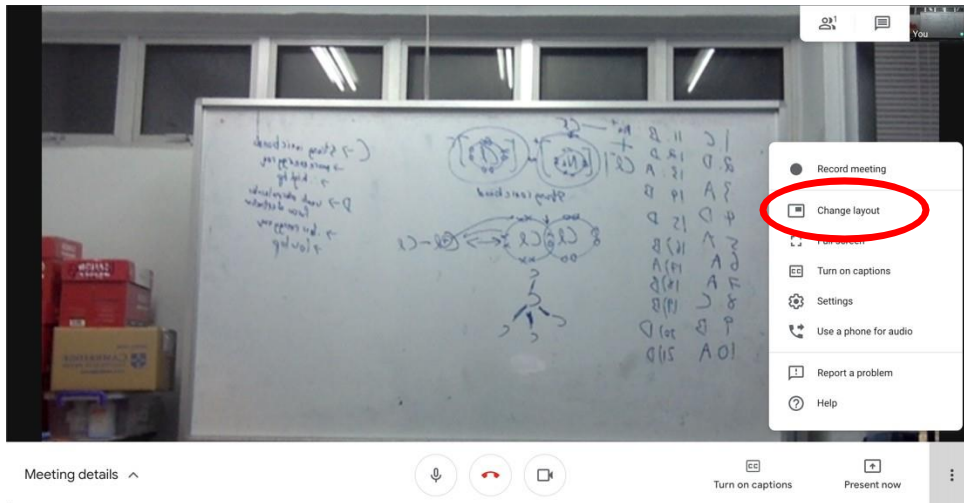
- 3) Once you are in, **MUTE** your microphone to reduce the ambient noise. You can unmute when you have questions to ask.



- 4) At the bottom of the screen, you can click “Turn on captions”, to create captions as your tutor teaches the class.



- 5) At the bottom right of the screen, select the options icon (3 dots). Then select “Change layout”, and choose either “Spotlight” or “Sideba”r (to maximise the screen usage)



- 6) Once that is done, identify your teacher’s profile, and hover over it. Click on the **PIN** that appears to ensure that the screen stays on the necessary picture.
- 7) Do note that your teacher may be recording the classes. **DO NOT** click the stop recording button. If you do so, **DO NOT** click start again, but **INFORM** your teacher.
- 8) Your teacher will guide you accordingly if more setup is needed.
